INTO MY LIFE

What passages of scripture have helped you in your fight for faithfulness to God?

God called Hosea to love someone who was difficult to love. How does the gospel empower you to love those who seem unlovable?

“This land is guilty of unfaithfulness to the LORD.” (vs 2) When you were in younger, what caused you to be guilty of unfaithfulness?

God used Hosea to bring spiritual perspective and peace to Gomer. Who did God use in your life to give you perspective and peace?

How is God calling you to be like Hosea and love the unlovable?

How is God supporting you to love the unlovable?
