John 6:35-51 & Joshua 2:1-24

### **GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER**

Jesus called Himself the Bread of Life. When it comes to actual bread, what is the best bread you've ever had? What made it so good?

### **INTO THE WORD**

Why were the people of Jericho a threat to God's people? (Deut. 18:9-14)

Why would the spies choose Rahab's house as a base in Jericho? What had Rahab heard about the God of the Israelites?

What characterized Rahab's faith at this time? (Psalm 111:10a) How was Rahab's fear of God different from the other people of Jericho?

How was Rahab's help rewarded? (Joshua 6:25)

How was Rahab remembered in the New Testament? (Matthew 1:1,5; Hebrews 11:31 and James 2:25-26)

### **INTO MY LIFE**

Does Rahab do a godly or ungodly thing in verses 4-7 when she lies about the spies' location? Were her lies necessary to accomplish God's purposes? When have you felt lying was necessary for you?

Can any lying still be godly?

Rahab came to faith and changed the way she lived. How has life changed for you since you've grown more mature in your faith?

Spoiler alert! The walls of Jericho came a-tumbling down! What they thought would protect them didn't. What used to give you a false sense of security in your life? What happened that changed your perspective?

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
