GROWTH GROUPS QUESTIONS

Exodus 3:1-15

GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER

If a non-burning burning bush talked to you, would you run away or listen? God told Moses to go back to Egypt but he didn't want to go. Where would it be terrifying for God to tell you to go? Why?

INTO THE WORD

Why did Moses flee from Egypt in the first place? (Exodus 2:11-15) What was Moses doing when away from Egypt? (vs.1) How did the past God gave Moses in Egypt and Midian make him uniquely qualified?

Why was Moses reluctant to go back to Egypt? (vs. 11) Was Moses more uncertain of himself of God? Why?

How does God identify Himself so that Moses should recognize Him in vs 6? How would Moses begin to understand that this God is way different than the Egyptian gods?

What does God reveal about Himself in this encounter? (e.g., His name, His power, His concern for His people)

INTO MY LIFE

What are some ways we can be more open to God's call and guidance in our lives?

Recall an event in your life when you felt like you were "standing on holy ground" What made that moment so special? How has that moment served you in your relationship with God?

What are some of the things happening in your life where you find this scenario playing out?

Pray for courage to go where God leads you (even if it's scary) and for confidence to see the value of submitting to God's plan and His working.

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
